### Final EURISOL Design Study Town Meeting

The **EURISOL Design Study** -- supported by the European Commission under Framework Programme 6 -- will hold the final Town Meeting in Pisa, Italy, from 30<sup>th</sup> March to 1<sup>st</sup> April, 2009, hosted by the INFN (Sez. di Pisa) and the University of Pisa. Some EURISOL committee and task-group meetings will take place on the 2<sup>nd</sup> of April. This Town Meeting will be an opportunity for an exchange of ideas and information between participants of EURISOL and the community at large. This meeting will also provide a forum for discussing the proposed EURISOL Collaboration, to be set up with the objective of continuing R&D and ensuring the future of the EURISOL project. **Venue:** The Town Meeting will be held in the Aula Magna auditorium of the Presidency of the Faculty of Mathematical, Physical and Natural Sciences of the University of Pisa. Invited presentations including a number of Nuclear Physics contributions will take place during the three-day meeting. A poster session, together with refreshments will be held on Monday in the late afternoon. A conference dinner has been arranged for Tuesday night in the nearby Santa Croce in Fossabanda, once a cloistered convent and now a hotel.

**Financial Support:** Students or Post-docs who submit a contribution may apply for partial financial support, by ticking the relevant box on their registration forms. Support will consist of reimbursement, against receipts, tickets, boarding passes, etc., for reasonable subsistence and travel costs, up to a maximum of 500€. The number of persons who can receive support will be limited by the available finance. Applicants will be informed of acceptance (or rejection) early in March.

**Accommodation:** A list of hotels in Pisa will be made available in the next announcement. A number of rooms will be pre-booked at various hotel and attendees should then make their own hotel reservations.
